
## To Our Customers

Tot only in symphony orchestras but also in modern popular orchestras, the tone quality of a true symphony instrument is now greatly in demand. The Symphony bore Olds plays with an ease of attack and a flexibility approaching that of the medium bore instrument, yet the tone quality is infinitely more sonorous and rich throughout its entire range. For those players with good embouchure and endurance who desire the utmost in tone quality this model is unhesitatingly recommended. The model is compact with comfortable grip and balance, classic in its simplicity. The generous bell size (43/4 inches) adds to the solidity of the tone.

A bore only slightly larger than medium but with lessened resistance because of thin tubing being used. The throat is generous in size; the volume sufficient to fill practically any need.

## SYMPHONY (Sym.)



Designed especially to retain compactness of tonal quality in the upper register, counteracting the microphone's tendency to shatter and deepen the pitch. 

## OLDS MOUTHPIECES



Olds mouthpieces are made in three models each for trombone, trumpet and cornet:

MODEL A-Furnished regularly with Olds instruments, has a medium cup, fairly broad and slightly rounded rim, with medium bore throat, designed to give the best results for allaround playing.

MODEL B-Is similar in size and type of rim to Model A, but has a rather shallow cup with high shoulders, making the

cup being undercut render the tone quality quite full even to the lowest register.

MODEL H-Has a deep cup with high shoulder, full rounded cup, moderately wide rim rounded off at the edge give the playing ease of a narrow rim with the support of the additional width.
